



The Power of the Heart Language:

Grace's Story

Grace (name changed) belongs to one of Iran's unreached ethnic minorities.

She was forced to marry at 14. Not long into her marriage, her husband began relations with other women. She began to pray to Allah to heal her marriage. She did not get an answer. Her marriage continued to break down. When she tried speaking to her husband about their relationship, he beat her with a belt. Her pleas were met with silence.

In her own words, "I was not respected; I was nameless because I am a woman."

There was no one to share her anguish with. Finally knowing the only hope for her and her two children was out of this marriage, she asked for a divorce. Her husband agreed. Her family completely cut her off. Now her greatest battle became poverty. There were days when the three of them had nothing to eat. She scraped for even the most menial jobs to make ends meet.

Years later, Grace met and married Barad. A kind man who loved her and agreed to be a father to her children. Her life started to change. Not long after that Barad was recruited to help translate the Bible into their heart language. Despite their Muslim faith, Barad was keen to make this significant literary contribution to his people group.

Grace was excluded from all these conversations. It was dangerous work. Her husband would take his laptop, go into another room and lock the door while he dialed in to the calls and discussed the translation with the team. When she objected, he told her only those in the committee could be in the meeting. But she was desperate to be a part of it. During the translation, Grace would sit in the hallway and overhear them trying to translate certain words. She would shout the correct translation back to them.

Just hearing the name of Jesus Christ touched Grace's heart and made her feel at ease. Her hunger increased. She wanted to know who this Jesus Christ is. Eventually she was allowed to join the team. Through the translation process both Barad and Grace came to know Jesus and decided to follow Him.

"The Word of God is love, friendship and peace. We want to translate this love into our language."

Now Grace goes to the park twice a day to share what she has received with others. In less than one year, she has shared the gospel with 600 others in her community and 80 have turned to Christ.

Iran is dangerous for Christians, but Grace adds, "Because of Jesus, I am no longer nameless. And I am not afraid of anything."

Your investment in Transform Iran enables us to reach the unreached and often forgotten communities of Iran. Through our efforts in Bible translation, we are able to present the gospel to them in their own heart language and disciple them when they choose to follow Christ.

As they begin to minister to others, we resource and equip them, enabling them to reach dozens and hundreds more with the message that saved them.

Why Iran?

Once the seat of the great Persian Empire, Iran continues to play a significant role on a global scale. Physically she occupies a strategically important location with coasts of the Persian Gulf, Gulf of Oman and the Caspian Sea, as well as the land between the Middle East and Central and South Asia. With her oil reserves and large energy industry (Iran holds some of the world's largest deposits of proved oil and natural gas reserves: world's fourth-largest holder of proven crude oil and second-largest natural gas reserve), influential military force, as well as significant religious influence in the world of Islam, Iran is considered one of the leading geopolitical powers of Western Asia.

BIBLE POVERTY: 23+million with no Bible in heart/primary language

ILLITERACY: 8-11%

(no reliable statistics; in 2023 the head of Iran's Literacy Movement Organization, stated 7.4 million age 6+ are "absolute illiterate", the former Minister of Education has said it is closer to 9 million)

PROSTITUTION: 1+ million women (and girls) trapped

CHILD LABOR: 700,000 child workers, including more than 100,000 street children

(no reliable statistics; in 2024, Reza Shafakhah of the human rights working group of the National Union of Bar Associations said there were 3 million working children in Iran)

UNDERAGE MARRIAGE: legal age for marriage is 13 for girls, 15 for boys

(legal age does not require parental consent; no minimum age with parental consent; marriages have been registered for girls as young as five; according to Iran Open Data, 1/5 marriages involve minors)

ADDICTION: 4.4 million addicted to drugs; one of the world's highest addiction rates

(according to WHO Iran has the highest rate of opium abusers in the world, with opium use at three times the global average; about 2 million people — 2.2% of population — use illicit drugs daily)

DEPRESSION: 18-22 million (20-25% of population) suffer mental health or development disorders, esp depression and anxiety disorder (in reality likely much higher: no recent/reliable studies)

SUICIDE: 19 per day, ~70k deaths per year (7.8% of population), mostly young people

(does not include attempted suicides; in 2024, 130,000 suicide attempts were officially recorded by the Ministry of Health — 356 per day; according to Gholam Abbas Torki, Ass. Prosecutor for Public Law and Crime Prevention in Iran, suicide is now the third leading cause of death amongst Iranians aged 15-24)

EXECUTIONS: second highest rate in the world; 883+ executed in 2024

(18.3% increase on previous year; equates to one in every 102k people; some sources estimate more than 1,000 executions)

REFUGEES: 3.8 million

(making Iran host to the largest refugee population in the world; Turkey is second with 3.3 million) $\,$

POVERTY: 40-60% of population below poverty line

(in 2024, Khabar Online reported 60%+ below the poverty line; in 2023 Iran's Ministry of Welfare reported 40% in absolute poverty)

YOUTH: 50% under the age of 35

The Iranian revolution of 1979 established a hardline Islamic regime; Christians faced increasing opposition and persecution: all missionaries were forcibly removed, evangelism was outlawed, Bibles in Persian were banned (it is illegal to own, print, import or distribute Bibles) and soon became scarce, and several pastors were martyred. In 2024, Open Doors ranked Iran as #9 most dangerous country for Christians.

Against this backdrop, the Iranian Church has become the fastest growing in the world and is influencing the region for Christ. More Iranians have become Christians in the last 45 years than in the previous 13 centuries put together since Islam came to Iran. In 1979, there were an estimated 500 Christians from a Muslim background in Iran and now, there are more than a million Iranian followers of Jesus.

THE PROBLEM: Hopelessness, lack of freedom, poverty, trauma. The people of Iran endure physical and emotional hardship and political control. Many millions have not yet heard the gospel.

THE SOLUTION: Freedom both in the natural and the spiritual. Ultimately, we believe the solution is the saving, loving, freeing love of Jesus Christ to penetrate all ranks of society and redeem our nation top to bottom. Everything we do, whether planting churches, discipling believers or broadcasting satellite programs... all of it exists to reach every man, woman and child in Iran with the love of Christ, and through that love, see a whole nation transformed.



1/ Effective Evangelism

We share the gospel in a way that can be easily **accessed (media)** and **understood (language)**.

Harnessing the Power of Media: We use media to reach the furthest corners of the nation. Every Iranian from the poorest and most remote through to the most exclusive and influential can access the gospel through our TV, radio and social media broadcasts.

Speaking their Heart Language: We use language the people understand (style, accent, dialect), with sounds they connect to (authentic Iranian music), in a way that can be clearly grasped (audiovideo allowing the illiterate and the casual surfers to easily connect). We also consider the age, gender, socio-economic status and literacy of our audience and create appropriate content.



2024 Challenges

In 2024, our challenges in ministry included:

COMMUNICATION WITH IRAN

The government is still cracking down and infiltrating every possible channel of communication. Seekers are afraid to be caught. Christians are at risk of isolation. We fight hard to keep communication open without compromising our team. All Iran leadership is decentralized.

"I was introduced to the Living God, Jesus Christ, through one of the dear sisters at 222 Church, whose heart was committed to Him. It changed my life. Living as a Christian in Iran has many challenges. We face so many limitations. We are living in a very intense, specific, closed situation. When I first gave my heart to Jesus I was worried about being isolated. I thought, "how are we going to connect with other believers?". I can't stress enough how hard my pastor and mentor worked to maintain connection with me (from outside Iran). Even when things were very chaotic and the network was being closed on and off by the authorities. She found a way. She made sure that our small group was not cut off from communication with believers outside the country. 222 Church has given us community."

CONFLICT WITH ISRAEL

Iran, Israel, Hamas, Hezbollah... In 2024, our news feeds were full of the developing conflict in this region. On the one hand, Iranians have increased anxiety for an uncertain future and impending war; on the other hand there is hopeless apathy with 'today's problems' overshadowing any fear for tomorrow. Whether we like it or not, the ongoing conflict with Isreal will have a direct impact on the lives of Iranians in 2025.

COST OF LIVING

Both Iran and Turkey battle high inflation rates. 45-50% in Turkey and almost 32% in Iran. In Turkey, refugees are limited in employment opportunities and have no access to insurance or benefits. Cost of housing is increasing with the ongoing influx of wealthy Russian and Ukrainian refugees, squeezing Iranian refugees out. It is a desperate situation. Housing is now the number one issue for refugee Christians in Turkey. Many have lost their homes and are living in appalling conditions. Tehran's Rial continues to plumet and poverty is gripping more than half the population. Cost of living has become the number one crisis in Iran.

TRAINING AND TRAVEL

Prohibitive travel costs and the loss of income (delegates forced to take unpaid leave from work to attend) make it harder for Iranians to participate in in-person training events. Additionally, refugees in Turkey are regularly being denied permission to travel out of their city (they need written permission from authorities to do so). This makes the accessibility of in-person training a significant challenge to overcome.

THREAT OF DEPORTATION

Refugees need a residence permit — Kimlik — to live in Turkey. In 2024, many of these were revoked with little to no notice, sending refugees directly to deportation camps and from there to Iran. This is unthinkable for many of our team. We respond quickly, enlisting legal help and at significant cost, help people out of prison and deportation camps in order to avert the danger of deportation. The pressure is unimaginable. One of our members was called in to the local station to be informed his Kimlik was denied and he was being sent to a deportation camp. The shock of the news caused a heart attack (right there in the station). Children share stories of classmates pulled out of class and told they are being deported.

CYBER SECURITY

Our team received constant direct, personal security threats from the government of Iran and their agents. Our systems are constantly being attacked. Even with strong security measures, breaches happen. Early in 2024 our websites were hacked. We were able close the breach within hours. In December they infiltrated Sama TV's YouTube and Instagram accounts taking years of accumulated content. After several days intensive effort God intervened with a miraculous recovery. But it was another warning. We have once again increased security across all our websites and communication platforms.

NEED FOR LEADERS

The need for more qualified dedicated anointed pastors to tend the constantly growing flock has not diminished. We continue to invest in quality leadership development.

MENTAL HEALTH

Iranians face a mental health crisis with rising depression, anxiety, prostitution, addiction and suicide. Less and less young people are getting married. Their hope for a better future is diminishing. They tell us time and again: there is no life; no future for us in Iran. People are traumatized in a myriad of ways. It is not possible to overestimate the brutality of the regime against its own people. The Church remains the only true light in oppressive darkness.

PERSECUTION OF CHILDREN

Children living as refugee Christians in Turkey are facing persecution and the pressure to embrace Islam. Some are beaten so badly that they end up in hospital. This constant pressure and mounting fear mean Christian children in Turkey battle depression and loneliness. In 2024 we began seriously tackling this issue through targeted ministry to children.

Even with all these barriers, Iranians continue to respond positively to Christ. We disciple them and connect them to the Body. There have been countless baptisms in secret, despite the danger. Many of these go on to plant new house churches. We do not publicize much of what is happening for security. We hold caution and wisdom in tension with boldness and courage. Be assured, the Church in Iran is growing!

"Despite all this which would normally paralyze a person, or bring an operation to its knees, God's presence has been tangible in all our gatherings and throughout this powerful network of united Spirit-filled believers. Every day I hear reports of God working in miraculous ways. We should be encouraged that we face these hurdles. The Kingdom of God is advancing in Iran. The light shines bright in the darkness and the darkness has not overcome it!"

Uprooted After 11 Years:

Mary's Story

The persecution the believers face in Turkey increases year on year. The instability they endure with the knowledge that at any moment they may be deported and sent back to certain imprisonment in Iran creates a huge amount of pressure and effects the mental health of everyone there from the youngest to the oldest.

Mary (name changed) is a single mother and a Bible translator. This is a transcript of a voice note she sent one of our leaders:

"I'll keep it short because I have no internet and no battery charge.

They gave us a letter forcing us to change our city—we moved to [other town], but actually, this is not the town at all; it's in the mountains. It's not good for my knee injury, nor for anything else.

I made a few friends and began finding accommodation but then someone blocked

my way and said I must pay a full year's rent in advance if I wanted to stay there. He said, "I don't know you; you're foreigners; I need assurances". But how am I support to come up with that kind of money? I need to pay the deposit, the first month's rent, electricity, water, and gas bills. Besides, I don't even have furniture to put in the house.

In short, we became really hopeless. We stayed in a hotel for so many nights that the hotel cost kept increasing. Then a Turkish person here had mercy on us and became my guarantor and said he would vouch for me. But after some time, he said that I must pay six months' rent in advance. We had no choice but to pay it. After that, we had to arrange water, electricity, and all other necessities.


Someone from [another town] who had come to faith through me before, came with his car and helped us. We were dealing with all this for a week, and finally, two days ago, the electricity and water were connected.

By God's grace, dear brother, I just wanted to say that I didn't even have time to go to church and say goodbye to the people there. Friends I had made for so many years! I was in so much pain and distress that I couldn't even bring myself to say goodbye. After 11 years, now I must move to another city and start again.

Maybe others have done the same, but with a sick child and all these difficulties, I really can't travel properly. I just wanted to ask you to let the people there know that I beg their forgiveness for not being able to say goodbye. I will tell them myself too, but I wanted you to know that I am now in [name of town]. We are completely alone again.

As you know, with the rules for refugees here, we are not allowed to go back to the town we were in before. But I think we are about two hours away. We'll see what God has planned for us.
